Regulatory Definition and Excerpt "supervisor" means a person who instructs, directs and controls workers in the performance of their duties; Workers Compensation Act - Part 2 Division 4 Section 23 - General Duties of Supervisors (1) Every supervisor must (a) ensure the health and safety of all workers under the direct supervision of the supervisor, (b) be knowledgeable about the OHS provisions and those regulations applicable to the work being supervised, and (c) comply with the OHS provisions, the regulations and any applicable orders. (2) Without limiting subsection (1), a supervisor must (a) ensure that the workers under the supervisor's direct supervision (i) are made aware of all known or reasonably foreseeable health or safety hazards in the area where they work, and (ii) comply with the OHS provisions, the regulations and any applicable orders, (b) consult and cooperate with the joint committee or worker health and safety representative for the workplace, and (c) cooperate with the Board, officers of the Board and any other person carrying out a duty under the OHS provisions or the regulations.

 New or Young workers under my supervision will have completed or be given an orientation that meets the requirements of BC OHSR 3.23. I will follow up with the CSO for any New or Young workers who will receive their New or Young worker orientation while at this site. 			
 All workers under my supervision will be provided with and use the necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for any task they are expected to perform. 			
 Any worker under my supervision who is exposed to a fall hazard will be instructed on the fall protection system for the area and the procedures to be used. I will follow up with the CSO for any workers who receive their instruction while at this site. 			
 If a worker cannot communicate in English another worker within the same scope of work who can act as a translator will be on site anytime the worker who cannot communicate in English is working on site. I will conduct and/or attend meetings required by the PCML H&S Program for safety coordination. I will promptly inform the First Aid Attendant, CSO, or Site Superintendent of any incident
