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## Inspection Record for Washroom Facilities

Employers must ensure washroom facilities are maintained in proper working order, kept clean and sanitary, and provided with the supplies necessary for their use. They must be serviced, cleaned, and sanitized as frequently as necessary to maintain them in a clean and sanitary condition. Sanitized means that surfaces have been treated by a process that destroys microorganisms that can cause disease or otherwise affect a worker's health.

With respect to the provision of supplies, each washroom should be provided with suitable waste receptacles and with the supplies necessary for the use of the facilities, such as a supply of soap or other hand sanitizer, toilet paper, and hand-drying towels or air dryers.
